Redbay Ltd is an SME that works primarily on our client's sites. The firm's assets are purely IT based and therefore our emissions are correspondingly low. To that end the scope 2 emissions are based on 4 people working from home per year. The vast majority of our emissions are Scope 3 emissions involving the travel and accommodation for staff when working away from our main contracted sites in London and Portsmouth.

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets:

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 11.7 tCO2e (0.585 per employee) which is a 25% reduction due to moving to public transport by default and the potential for employees to purchase electric vehicles for business journeys. This is based on an estimated company growth of to 20 employees in the next 5 years.

In the future Redbay is investing in a carbon offset firm which will ensure that Redbay is Carbon Neutral by the end of 2026.
